



Dear Friends,

Paul wrote: I laid a foundation like a wise master builder according to God's grace that was given to me, but someone else is building on top of it. Each person needs to pay attention to the way they build on it. No one can lay any other foundation besides the one that is already laid, which is Jesus Christ. So, whether someone builds on top of the foundation with gold, silver, precious stones, wood, grass, or hay, each one's work will be clearly shown. The day will make it clear, because it will be revealed with fire—the fire will test the quality of each one's work. (1 Corinthians 3:1-13 CEB)

Just as team members change on any sports team, team members in the church also change. In light of that, I have decided to make a change for myself, which will also be a change for all of you. At the end of June 2022, I will re-retire, and you will have a new pastor beginning July 1.

Our district superintendent, Rev Taesung Kang, will work with our Staff Parish Relations Committee to learn what qualities and gifts will most help building the team work here at First UMC so the Bishop and cabinet can prayerfully discern who is the right person to be the pastor here.

I ask you to pray for the SPRC, our DS, and the Bishop and cabinet as they begin this process. I also ask that you pray for the entire congregation while going through the transition. I will help with that process, as well. We have much more time together, so let's keep building and growing! Let's be a team and create significant ministries so we can continue to make a difference in this world!


### **ANNUAL CHURCH CONFERENCE**




### SPRC MEETING VIA ZOOM




