A FAVORITE RECIPE FROM SUZANNE OLBRICHT



Blueberry Oatmeal Bars

Oven: 350

Pan: 8 x 8 inches. Grease and line with parchment paper with a bit of an overhang on each side.

Crust and crumbles - Mix together:

1 cup all purpose flour

1 1/2 cup rolled oats (I used Red Mill)

2/3 cup granulated sugar

2/3 cup melted butter (cooled slightly)

Press 2/3 of the mixture in the bottom of the pan. Set aside 1/3 (about 2/3 cup packed) for the crumbles.

Blueberry filling - Mix together:

2 cups blueberries (fresh or frozen) (I used wild Maine blueberries)

1/4 cup sugar

2 tsp cornstarch

1 T lemon juice

Zest of 1 large lemon


Pour the blueberry mixture over the crust.

Then crumble the remaining oatmeal mixture over the blueberries. Gently press the crumbles into the blueberries so they stick


CARING FOR EACH OTHER
