

Looking ahead, we won't see property insurance payments resume until September, and our heating costs are down, offering some welcome relief.




Thank you for all the ways you continue to support our church community, with your gifts, your energy, and your heart. Let's carry that spirit into the season ahead.

Good news on the Joshua House! The new waterline is in, and we were granted occupancy to the new side of the building a couple of weeks ago. Furniture is in and families and staff are now sleeping/living on the new side of the building as of mid-June. With the move to the new side, we have more bedrooms again! At this stage, we will be able to shelter 4-5 families at a time again. Construction will begin immediately on the new kitchen, followed by construction on the remaining portion of the existing house.


Currently, we will be operating out of a temporary kitchen. Families have access to the refrigerators, a countertop toaster oven, air fryer, microwave, and kitchen/food supplies as normal. They also have storage space to keep their own food items but have very limited storage space overall. There is currently no oven/stove. So, when preparing food, please bring it to the Joshua House already fully prepared and warm in disposable containers.

We are currently at 4 families, but updated family numbers will be provided just prior to our next rotation. Our next rotation for providing meals for the families at Joshua House is August 14 - 16, 2025. Please contact Jen Berry at jen_b76@yahoo.com if you would like to help.

Another positive update - the coordinators and volunteers have raised almost \$6000 in Pati's name for the Joshua House construction! Woo Hoo! God is good!




CARING FOR EACH OTHER










On June 8th we welcomed new Members Dianne and Emily Pierce, Wayne Rasch, and Steve Beckert to the First UMC Church Family!


PLANET RANGERS GRAND FINALE - WIZARDS & WANDS

We are so fortunate to partner with the Planet Rangers team that brings kids from all around the Seacoast to experience their after school programs. Here are some photos of their finale.








