



Baptism with Laying on of Hands

L: *Jackson,* I baptize you in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit.

All: Amen.

(The pastor, parents, sponsors and others immediately lay hands upon the child individually as the pastor says)

L: The Holy Spirit work with you, that being born through water and the Spirit, you may be a faithful disciple of Jesus Christ.

All: Amen.

(The pastor invites the congregation to welcome the child)

L: Let us welcome our new brother in Christ.

P: Child of God by water and the Spirit, we welcome you into God's new creation. Share with us in Christ's royal priesthood. With joy and thanksgiving we welcome you as a member of Christ's church.

(Here the pastor takes the newly baptized into the congregation as (a) new sibling/siblings in Christ. Returning them to the parents and/or sponsors, and giving of the certificate and gifts.)

L: Sisters and brothers in Christ: through the sacrament of baptism God's Spirit initiates us into Christ's holy church, puts us on the stage of God's saving drama, and gives us new birth through water and the Spirit.

So, come to the water -- water poured over and immersing us, water flowing freely for all who will receive it, water from the streams of God's saving power and justice, water that brings hope to all who thirst for righteousness, water that refreshes life, nurtures growth, and offers new birth.

Here we come to the waters, to baptize a *child*, and in each other's presence to renew our commitments to Christ who has raised us, the Spirit who has birthed us, and the Creator who is making all things new.

Renunciation of Sin and Profession of Faith

(Pastor to all the people, and especially parents and sponsors)
L: And so I ask you, will you turn away from the powers of sin and death?

P: We

renounce the spiritual forces of wickedness, reject the evil powers of this world, and repent of our sin!

L: Will you let the Spirit use you as prophets to the powers that be?

P: We accept the freedom and power God gives us to resist evil, injustice, and oppression in whatever forms they present themselves!

L: Will you proclaim the good news and live as disciples of Jesus Christ, his body on earth?

P: We confess Jesus Christ as our Savior, put our whole trust in his grace, and promise to serve him as our Lord, in union with the church which Christ has opened to people of all ages, nations, and races!

(The pastor addressing the parents and/or other sponsors)

L: Will you nurture this child, *Jackson Stone Geoffrion*, in Christ's holy church?

(The parents and sponsors respond)

P: By teaching and example we will guide *him* to accept God's grace for *himself*, to profess *his* faith openly, and to lead a Christian life.

(The pastor addressing all the people)

L: Will you be living witnesses to the gospel, individually and together, wherever you are, and in all that you do?

P: We will remain faithful members of Christ's holy church and serve as Christ's representatives in the world.

L: Will you nurture one another in living the faith of the church and include *Jackson* in your care? **P:**

With God's help we will live the gospel of Jesus Christ. We will embody faith, hope and love so that *Jackson* will grow up to trust God and live Love's service in the world. We will pray for *his* on *his* journey of discipleship among us.

L: Will you receive and profess the Christian faith as contained in the Scriptures of the Old and New Testaments?

P: We affirm and teach the faith of the whole church as we put our trust in God, the Father Almighty, Jesus Christ God's only Son, and in the Holy Spirit, one God now and forever.

*The Apostles' Creed (unison)

I believe in God the Father Almighty, maker of heaven and earth;

And in Jesus Christ his only Son our Lord: who was conceived by the Holy Spirit, born of the Virgin Mary, suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, dead, and buried; the third day he rose from the dead; he ascended into heaven, and sitteth at the right hand of God the Father Almighty; from thence he shall come to judge the quick and the dead.

I believe in the Holy Spirit, the holy catholic* church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and the life everlasting. Amen.

(*meaning universal)

Thanksgiving over the Water

L: The Spirit of the Lord is with us.

P: Even so, come Lord Jesus!

L: Let us pray: Almighty God, the life you birthed in us by baptism into Jesus Christ will never die. Your justice never fails. Your mercy is everlasting.

P: Your healing river flows. Your Spirit blows where you will. We cannot stop you, God!

L: But sometimes we try. We try to block the flow, we redirect the winds of the Spirit, or we walk so far away from the lifegiving stream that we do not hear its sound, and we forget its power. We parch ourselves.

P: We are dry and thirsty, O God. Come, refresh us!

L: Come upon us, Holy Spirit!

P: Come upon us, Holy Spirit!

L: Come upon these waters.

P: Come upon these waters.

L: Let these waters be to us drops of your mercy.

P: Let these waters remind us of your righteousness and justice.

L: Let these waters renew in us the resurrection power of Jesus.

P: Let these waters make us long for your coming reign.
