

Dear Church Family,

I hope that this letter finds you enjoying your summer.

I am writing to ask if you would consider making a 'One Time' donation to help defray the costs of re-roofing Sanborn Hall? I'm sure you are aware that we needed to do some repairs to the Sanctuary slate roof. As the roofing contractor was proceeding with the repairs, he noticed that the asphalt shingle roof on Sanborn Hall and the section adjoining the hall with the Sanctuary roof was in need of replacement. Those shingles were well beyond their thirty year life. He contacted a roofing company he has dealt with in the past and received a quote to strip and reshingle the roof for \$24,000.00. The trustees received a competitor's bid for the same job at \$36,000.00. The trustees felt that it was prudent to have the job done right away, especially since the roof section above Sanborn Hall doors needed to be done to tie into the new valley flashing that he was installing. While we saved the church about \$12,000.00 doing both roofs, we had to borrow money from our line of credit to the tune of about \$30,000.00. Some of this will be re-paid from the remainder of the Capital Campaign pledges yet to come in.

This was not an easy decision, especially in light of the fact that we are just finishing up our most recent Capital Campaign. The church is also facing some other 'major' expenses in the not too distant future, i.e. more stone work repair and replacing one of the boilers that is very old, re-modeling the downstairs bathrooms, etc. It is my hope that we can pay off the line of credit quickly. For example, if 30 of us each gave an extra \$1000.00, we could eliminate the debt right away. I know that's a lot of money for some, so I am hoping that those who have been blessed with more will consider giving a little more. No gift is too small, all gifts are greatly appreciated.
