CHURCH TRUSTEES UPDATE

Church Family,

We are having some remodeling work done in the Randall Room. The Fire Dept. has 'strongly suggested' that the wooden paneling be removed and replaced with sheetrock.

The little 'kitchenette' at the far end of the room, is quite outdated and not very functional. We will be removing that 'separating' wall, the old cabinets as well as insulating the two exterior walls prior to hanging new sheetrock. The handyman we hired will be performing all of this work, getting the room ready to paint. He also will be re-installing the 'track' for the hung ceiling panels. We may want to think about buying new panels (this is not within the scope of the handyman's contract.) The tile floor needs some attention also. The trustees are hoping we can clean them easier than replacing.

We are also working on the needed masonry repairs, most of you know we had some of the concrete lentils fail this winter. That work we hope to start in April. We do have a quote from a roofing contractor who specializes in slate roofs lined up to do some repairs.

We also took down the stage curtain (it has lived a long and useful life but sadly that has come to an end), how does it look without it? We do have a gently used stage curtain (thank you St. James Church) that may be installed in the near future.
